A ORDINANCE TO FILE SUIT

WHEREAS Lafayette Mills Apartments, through it manager, alleges it does not owe the amount alleged; now therefore


BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of West Lafayette, State of Ohio as follows:

SECTION I: The Village Solicitor, William.M. Owens, is authorized and directed to file a lawsuit to collect the amount allegedly owed in Coshocton Municipal Court.

SECTION II: The Village Fiscal Officer is authorized and directed to prepare a check payable to the Coshocton Municipal Court in the amount of Eighty Six and 00/100 (\$86.00) Dollars for filing fees.


