A RESOLUTION BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF WEST LAFAYETTE, COSHOCTON COUNTY, OHIO, AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE VILLAGE MAYOR TO SUBMIT A GRANT APPLICATION WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY (DHS) AND STATE AND LOCAL CYBERSECURITY GRANT PROGRAM (SLCGP) FOR THE ROUND 3 .GOV DOMAIN MIGRATION GRANT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio, through the **DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY (DHS)**, and the **STATE AND LOCAL CYBERSECURITY GRANT PROGRAM (SLCGP)**, administers financial assistance for **.gov Domain Migration**; and

WHEREAS, moving to a **.gov domain** strengthens the village's digital security and public trust; and

WHEREAS, the maximum grant award per project is \$9,500 with a Local cost share of 20%; and

WHEREAS, the Village of West Lafayette desires financial assistance under the **Department of Homeland Security and State and Local Cybersecurity Grant Program**.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the Village of West Lafayette, Ohio as follows:

1. That Council of the Village of West Lafayette approves filing an application for Round 3 .gov Domain Migration Grant.
2. That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to execute *and* file an application with the **Department of Homeland Security and State and Local Cybersecurity Grant Program** and to provide all information and documentation required to become eligible for possible funding assistance.
3. That the Village of West Lafayette does agree to obligate the funds required to satisfactorily complete the proposed project and become eligible for reimbursement under the terms and conditions of the **Department of Homeland Security and State and Local Cybersecurity Grant Program**.
4. This resolution is hereby declared an emergency measure, and its immediate passage is necessary to preserve, protect and maintain the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village of West Lafayette, Ohio and must be passed for the application to be submitted prior to the deadline of March 13, 2026. Therefore, this Resolution shall be in force immediately upon its passage and approval.


