A RESOLUTION BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF WEST LAFAYETTE, COSHOCTON COUNTY, OHIO, AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE VILLAGE MAYOR TO REQUEST FUNDING FOR THE WATERWORKS PARK IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT THROUGH THE STATE CAPITAL BUDGET COMMUNITY PROJECT FUNDING AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.


WHEREAS, the State of Ohio, through the **STATE CAPITAL BUDGET COMMUNITY PROJECT FUNDING**, administers financial assistance to local government entities for projects that benefit the community,

WHEREAS, the Village of West Lafayette desires financial assistance under the **STATE CAPITAL BUDGET COMMUNITY PROJECT FUNDING** in the amount of \$200,000 (Two hundred thousand dollars) for a splash pad, restrooms, ball field, trees and benches at Waterworks Park with no local match required.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Village of West Lafayette as follows:


1. That Village of West Lafayette approves filing an application for **STATE CAPITAL BUDGET COMMUNITY PROJECT FUNDING**.
2. That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to execute *and* file an application with the **STATE CAPITAL BUDGET COMMUNITY PROJECT FUNDING** and to provide all information and documentation required to become eligible for possible funding assistance.
3. That the Village of West Lafayette does agree to obligate the funds required to satisfactorily complete the proposed project and become eligible for reimbursement under the terms and conditions of the **STATE CAPITAL BUDGET COMMUNITY PROJECT FUNDING**
4. This resolution is hereby declared an emergency measure, and its immediate passage is necessary to preserve, protect and maintain the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village of West Lafayette, Ohio and must be passed for the application to be submitted prior to the deadline of March 12, 2026. Therefore, this Resolution shall be in force immediately upon its passage and approval.
