A RESOLUTION BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF WEST LAFAYETTE, COSHOCTON COUNTY, OHIO, AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE VILLAGE MAYOR TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION WITH SENATOR MORENO'S OFFICE FOR COMMUNITY PROJECT FUNDING REQUESTS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2027, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Senator Moreno's office will be accepting Community Project Funding requests for Fiscal Year 2027 to include a 20% local match; and

WHEREAS, the Village of West Lafayette desires financial assistance for storm water mitigation infrastructure under the Community Project Funding; and


WHEREAS, the Village has received estimates from Environmental Design Group and Verdantas to date in the amount of \$6,181,960; and

WHEREAS, the Village will secure other grant funding to cover the required local match.


NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Village of West Lafayette as follows:

1. That Village of West Lafayette approves filing an application for Community Project Funding Requests for Fiscal Year 2027.
2. That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to execute *and* file an application with Senator Moreno's office and to provide all information and documentation required to become eligible for possible funding assistance.
3. This resolution shall be declared an emergency measure necessary to preserve the health, welfare and safety of the citizens of the Village of West Lafayette, Ohio, the emergency being to meet the March 30, 2026 application deadline and shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon its passage by Council and signing of the Mayor.
