West Lafayette Village Council met in regular session at 7:00 P.M., in the municipal building with Mayor Jack L. Patterson presiding.

Pledge of Allegiance

Roll Call:

The Ohio Rural Development is offering this class for \$200.00 per person. Dave wants Travis and Tye to attend this training to help prepare them for their test in May. VA would like to remind the public that all leaves need to be bagged before the street workers will pick them up. Time Warner has donated the 1 acre lot. The new deed has been filed. Grant Applications: The grant for the fences for the ball diamonds came through. The Ridgewood Recreation Board is currently working on the parking lot. Council had a discussion about the progress with the ball diamonds. Traffic control specifically was discussed in detail. However, some council members didn't agree because the original agreement with the recreation board was that there would be no additional cost to the village now or in the future. Dave said that he received a quote from a local contractor of \$4000.00 to properly extend this alley. Councilmember Loos made a motion to extend the discussed alley by approximately 180 feet. Motion seconded by Gossett. (4 yes, 2 no)
