## **ORDINANCE TO PERMIT SHOOTING RANGE AT WASTE WATER PLANT**

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of West Lafayette, State of Ohio as follows:

SECTION I. The Village of West Lafayette, Ohio owns 6.0 ± acres of land, which is presently used for a waste water treatment plant.

SECTION II. The Village of West Lafayette, Ohio declares it has a need, which is in the best interest of its citizens, to create a Firearm Target Range for use by law enforcement personnel and for those persons invited and supervised by law enforcement personnel.

SECTION III: The Village of West Lafayette, Ohio authorizes and directs the Village Administrator to construct and utilize a Firearms Target Range on the 6.0 ± acres of land now used for a waste treatment plant. Said target range shall be utilized by law enforcement personnel and by those persons invited and supervised by law enforcement personnel.

SECTION IV: The Firearms Target Range will be utilized for yearly qualifications, target practice, and for improvement of shooting skills. No person shall use the firing range unless he is a law enforcement officer or is in the presence of a uniformed officer, or plain clothed officer, if the officer does not usually wear a uniform in the performance of his duties; such as and including but not by means of limitation, the Marshall.
