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## **RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A SPECIAL REVENUE FEMA GRANT FUND 290 FOR THE ACCOUNTING OF FUNDS RECEIVED FROM FEMA FOR THE VILLAGE OF WEST LAFAYETTE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, in September, 2008 Coshocton County was declared to be a disaster area resulting from wind storm that occurred on September 14, 2008; and

**WHEREAS**, the Council for the Village of West Lafayette designated the Village Administrator as the Village's agent and subsequent authority to make application for funding for reimbursement of expenditures incurred during the September wind storm; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to standards established by the Auditor of State, it is necessary to create a Special Revenue Fund by resolution of the legislative authority for the purpose of accounting for Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) funds.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the Village of West Lafayette, Coshocton County, Ohio that:


Section 1. The Council of the Village of West Lafayette does hereby create and establish a new fund called the FEMA Grant Fund. The purpose of this fund will be to record and document FEMA grants received by the Village of West Lafayette. This fund is established under the auspices of Auditor of State Bulletin 98-013.

Section 2. The revenues for the fund will be from FEMA grants received for reimbursement of funds expended by the Village on FEMA approved projects.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take affect be in full force at the earliest time allowed by law.
