AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE WATER AND SEWER RATES, FOR 2010 FOR THE VILLAGE OF WEST LAFAYETTE, OHIO, AMENDING ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS IN CONFLICT HEREWITH

WHEREAS, a rate increase is required to offset increases in the cost of operations and maintenance of the water and sewer services departments and

WHEREAS, the water and sewage treatment facilities are in need of a capital improvements upgrade to conform to environmental protection standards,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of West Lafayette, State of Ohio, as follows:

That the monthly rates for water consumption by residents of the Village of West Lafayette, Ohio for all SECTION 1: billings on or after January 1, 2010 shall be as follows:

First 2000 gallons Next 3000 gallons Next 3000 gallons Next 3000 gallons Over 12,000 gallons	\$8.90 per 1000 gallons \$7.29 per 1000 gallons \$5.82 per 1000 gallons \$4.66 per 1000 gallons
Over 12,000 gailons	\$3.79 per 1000 gallons

SECTION 2:

That the monthly sewer rates for residents of the Village of West Lafayette, Ohio, shall be based on water consumption, shall be for all billings on and after January 1, 2010, and shall be as follows:

\$5.39 per 1000 gallons for water consumption

SECTION 3: That the minimum billing shall be defined as 2000 gallons per month for water and/ or sewer.

That the non-residents of the Village of West Lafayette, Ohio, who are connected to the village water SECTION 4: and/or sewer system shall be billed at one and one-half time the rates as set forth in Section 1,

Section 2, and Section 3.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
