A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE VILLAGE OF WEST LAFAYETTE TO PREPARE AND EXECUTE AN APPLICATION TO THE SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL PROGRAM FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF A SCHOOL TRAVEL PLAN.

The following is a Resolution enacted by the Village of West Lafayette, Coshocton County, Ohio, hereinafter referred to as the Local Public Agency (LPA), in the matter of the stated described project.

WHEREAS, the United States Congress has set aside monies for Safe Routes to School Projects through the State of Ohio, Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, LPAs can apply for these monies and be selected for funding by the State of Ohio, Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, the development of a School Travel Plan is a transportation activity eligible to receive federal funding; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of West Lafayette, State of Ohio, that:

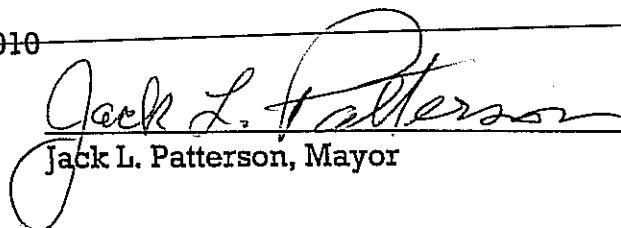
SECTION ONE: The Mayor of said LPA is hereby empowered on behalf of the LPA to prepare and execute an application for SRTS funds for the stated described project and to submit same to the State of Ohio, Department of Transportation.

SECTION TWO: The total cost of the project is estimated to be \$2,000.00, of which the LPA, if awarded the funds, will receive 100% of estimated project cost. The LPA further agrees to pay One Hundred Percent (100%) of the cost over and above the maximum amount provided by the State of Ohio, Department of Transportation.


SECTION THREE: If the application is approved for the funding the Mayor of said LPA is hereby empowered on behalf of the LPA to enter into a contract with the Director of the Ohio Department of Transportation necessary to complete the above described project.

This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure to take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage to meet the Safe Routes to School application deadline.
