Ordinance No.: 2011-21

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PLACEMENT OF A LEVY ON THE NOVEMBER GENERAL ELECTION BALLOT FOR A ONE HALF PERCENT INCOME TAX INCREASE DESIGNATING THE ONE HALF PERCENT FOR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FOR MAINTENANCE, REPAIR, REPLACEMENT AND IMPROVEMENTS OF STREETS, ALLEYS, SIDEWALKS, AND CURBS IN THE VILLAGE

WHEREAS the Village of West Lafayette, Ohio is in need of capital improvements for the Village streets, alleys, sidewalks, and curbs; and

WHEREAS the General Fund of the Village of West Lafayette, Ohio does not generate sufficient funds to provide the necessary maintenance, repair, replacement and improvements for the streets, alleys, sidewalks, and curbs,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of West Lafayette, State of Ohio as follows:

SECTION I. That the Mayor and Village Administrator are hereby authorized to request by a vote of the citizens to levy a tax on one-half percent to be used exclusively for maintenance, repair, replacement, and improvements of Village streets, alleys, sidewalks, and curbs and place said levy on the November General Election.

SECTION II. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation for the public peace, welfare and safety, the emergency being for the reason that said ordinance is needed immediately to provide services for the citizens of the Village of West, and this ordinance shall, therefore, take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage by Council and approved by the Mayor.
