AN RESOLUTION PLACING ON THE BALLOT A PROPOSAL TO RAISE VILLAGE INCOME TAX AN ADDITIONAL ONE-HALF PERCENT FOR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS FOR MAINTENANCE, REPAIR, REPLACEMENT, AND IMPROVEMENTS OF THE VILLAGE STREETS, ALLEYS, SIDEWALKS, AND CURBS,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of West Lafayette, State of Ohio as follows:

SECTION I. That the Mayor and Village Administrator be and are hereby authorized to take all necessary steps as prescribed in Section 718.01 et al of the Ohio Revised Code to place on the ballot for a vote of the citizens to levy an income tax of one-half percent for capital improvements for maintenance, repair, replacement, and improvement of Village streets, alleys, sidewalks, and curbs.

SECTION II. That, if passed, this tax shall become due and be effective January 1, 2012, and be part of the Village Income Tax Code that applies to all other collection of taxes.

SECTION III. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation for the public peace, welfare and safety, the emergency being for the reason that said ordinance is needed immediately to provide services for the citizens of the Village of West Lafayette, Ohio, and this ordinance shall, therefore, take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor.
