A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO SIGN AND SUBMIT A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY FOR ITS ASSISTANCE TO FIREFIGHTERS GRANT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the West Lafayette Volunteer Fire Department (WLAfVD), through the Village of West Lafayette is eligible to participate in the U.S. Department of Homeland Security's "Assistance to Firefighters Grant" (AFG) Program;

WHEREAS, the WLAfVD thru its governing body the Village of West Lafayette desires to participate in the AFG Program;

WHEREAS, the WLAfVD may be eligible for up to \$170,065 in grant funding from the AFG program;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of West Lafayette, Coshocton County:

Section 1: That the Village Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to submit the grant application to AFG program.

Section 2: That if the grant is awarded the WLAfVD will be responsible for a matching share of 5% of the awarded amount. If the total grant of \$170,065 is awarded, the WLAfVD will be responsible for \$8,532.

Section 3: That if the WLAfVD receives funding from AFG for the grant application as prepared by Barbara Ross of Grant Source Professionals, LLC; Barbara will be entitled to a fee of 8% of the amount awarded up to a maximum of \$3,500.00.

Section 4: That this resolution shall be and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for reason that the application period ends on September 16, 2011, and for reason thereof this resolution shall be effective immediately upon passage, signing by the Mayor, and posting.
