**RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A SPECIAL REVENUE FUND 210 FOR
ACCOUNTING OF FUNDS FOR THE FIRE DEPARTMENT AND DECLARING
AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Council for the Village of West Lafayette wishes to establish a new fund (210) for the Fire Department.

WHEREAS, pursuant to standards established by the Auditor of State, it is necessary to create a Special Revenue Fund by resolution of the legislative authority for the purpose of accounting for levied funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of West Lafayette, Coshocton County, Ohio that:

Section 1. The Council of the Village of West Lafayette does hereby create and establish a new fund called the Fire Department Funds. The purpose of this fund will be to record and document all receipts and disbursements of levy monies. Interest, if any, derived from any investments from this fund shall be credited to this 210 fund.

Section 2. This Resolution shall take affect be in full force at the earliest time allowed by law.
