A RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING THE PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO THE 911 EMERGENCY SYSTEM PLAN BE ADOPTED:

WHEREAS, the Village of West Lafayette seeks to ensure the 911 System is adequately staffed;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of West Lafayette, Coshoccon County Ohio:

Section 1: Recommend the following amendment to the Coshoccon County 911 Emergency Plan be adopted:

Section 9b. Effective January 1, 2012 funds to pay dispatchers, 911 Coordinator and the Commissioners Communications Specialist wages may be paid from the 911 Fund not to exceed 50% of the 911 Fund Balance at the beginning of any one calendar year.

Section 2. That this resolution shall be and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for reason that the Village needs to ensure adequate staffing in the 911 system, and for reason thereof this resolution shall be effective immediately upon passage, signing by the Mayor, and posting.
