**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE FISCAL OFFICER TO CERTIFY FUNDS FOR ROUND 27:
KIRK STREET/UNION AVENUE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT**

Whereas, the State Capital Improvement Program and the Local Transportation Improvement Program both provide financial assistance to political subdivisions for capital improvements to public infrastructure, and

Whereas, the Village of West Lafayette is planning to make capital improvements known as **KIRK STREET/UNION AVENUE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT**, and

Whereas, the infrastructure improvement herein above described is considered to be a priority need for the community and is a qualified project under OPWC programs,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY the **VILLAGE OF WEST LAFAYETTE COUNCIL**:

Section 1: That the Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized and directed to Certify Funds availability for the **Round 27: KIRK STREET/UNION AVENUE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT**.

Section 2: That this resolution shall be and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for reason that the Village needs to apply needs to submit the application by November 2nd, 2012, and for reason thereof this resolution shall be effective immediately upon passage, signing by the Mayor, and posting.
