# RESOLUTION DECLARING IT NECESSARY TO LEVY A TAX IN EXCESS OF THE TEN MILL LIMITATION

Rev. Code, Sec. 5705.19,.191,.194,.21,.26

The Council of the village of West Lafayette, Coshocton County, State of Ohio, met in special session on the 5TH day of August, 2013, at the office of Council of the Village of West Lafayette with the following members present:

**WHEREAS,** The amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten mill limitation will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of said Village of West Lafayette, Coshocton County, Ohio;

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Sec. 5705.19 (A) authorizes a levy outside the tenmill limitation for general operating purposes;

WHEREAS, the Auditor of Coshocton County, Ohio has given certification of the total current valuation the taxing district of the Village of West Lafayette, Ohio and the dollar amount of revenue generated by the specific millage of seven (7.0) mills; as per Ohio Revised Code, Section 5705.03

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The Village of West Lafayette, Coshocton County, Ohio, two-thirds of all members elected thereto concurring, that it is necessary to levy a tax in excess of the ten mill limitation for the benefit of Village of West Lafayette for the purpose of General Operating Expenses for the Village, which shall include without limitation operating expenses for the Police Department, which levy is a renewal of three (3) Mills and an additional levy of four (4) Mills, to constitute a tax of seven (7.0) mills at a rate not exceeding seven(7.0) mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to No Dollars and Seventy Cents (\$.70) for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for a period of five (5) years.

Resolution No.: 2013 -24 Passed: August 5, 2013 RESOLVED, That the question of levying additional taxes be submitted to the electors of said Village of West Lafayette at the Primary election to be held at the usual voting places within said Village of West Lafayette on the 5th day of November. 2013; and be it further RESOLVED, That said levy be placed upon the tax list of the current year after the February settlement next succeeding the election, commencing 2013 and first due in 2014, if Majority of the electors voting thereon vote in favor thereof; and be it further RESOLVED, That the Clerk-Fiscal Officer of this Council of the Village of West Lafayette be and she is hereby directed to certify a copy of the Resolution to the Board of Election, Coshocton County, Ohio and notify said Board of Elections to cause notice of election on the question of levying said tax to be given as required by law.
