Whereas, the **Village of West Lafayette** is planning to make capital improvements known as **Alley Paving Program 2014**, and


Whereas, the infrastructure improvement herein above described is considered to be a priority need for the community and is a qualified project under OPWC programs,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY the **VILLAGE OF WEST LAFAYETTE COUNCIL**:


Section 1: That the Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized and directed to Certify Funds availability for the **Alley Paving Program 2014**.
