Ohio for the purpose of <u>Current General Operating Expenses for the Village</u>, at a rate not exceeding <u>three (3.0)</u> mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to <u>No Dollars and Thirty Cents (\$.30)</u> for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for <u>a</u> renewal of an existing tax of three (3) mills for five years commencing in the tax year <u>2015</u> first due in calendar year <u>2016</u>.
