

RESOLUTION DECLARING IT NECESSARY TO LEVY A TAX IN EXCESS OF THE TEN MILL LIMITATION

REVISED CODE SECTION (I) 5705.19(J)

The Council for the Village of West Lafayette of COSHOCTON County, Ohio, met in regular session on the 28th day of July, 2014, at the office of Village Council with the following members present:

M Craig Bordenkircher moved the adoption of the following Resolution:

WHEREAS, The amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten mill limitation will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of said Village of West Lafayette,

COSHOCTON County, Ohio; therefore be it

RESOLVED, by the Village Council of West Lafayette, of COSHOCTON County, Ohio, two-thirds of all members elected thereto concurring, that it is necessary to levy a tax in excess of the ten mill limitation for the benefit of Village of West Lafayette, Ohio for the purpose of the payment of salaries of permanent or part-time police, communications, or administrative personnel to operate the Police Department including the payment of any employer contributions required for such personnel under Section 145.48 or 742.33 of the Revised Code, at a rate not exceeding two (2) mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to No Dollars and Twenty Cents (\$.20) for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for an additional tax of two (2) mills for five years commencing in the tax year 2014 first due in calendar year 2015.

RESOLVED, that the question of levying additional taxes be submitted to the electors of said Village of West Lafayette, Ohio

At the General election to be held at the usual voting places within said Village of West Lafayette, Ohio on the 4<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2014; and be it further

RESOLVED, that said levy be placed upon the tax list of the current year after the February settlement next succeeding the election, if a majority of electors voting thereon vote in favor thereof; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Clerk-Fiscal Officer of this Council for the Village of West Lafayette, Ohio be and she is hereby directed to certify a copy of the Resolution to the Board of Elections

COSHOCTON County, Ohio declaring it a necessity to levy a tax in excess of the ten mill limitation.

And notify said Board of Elections to cause notice of election on the question of levying said tax to be given as required by law for the November 4, 2014 election.

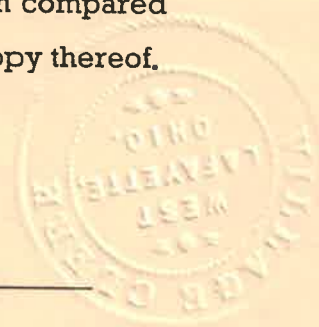
