RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A SPECIAL REVENUE FUND 218 FOR ACCOUNTING OF FUNDS FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT LEVY

WHEREAS, the Council for the Village of West Lafayette wishes to establish a new fund (218) for the Police activity.

WHEREAS, pursuant to standards established by the Auditor of State, it is necessary to create a Special Revenue Fund by resolution of the legislative authority for the purpose of accounting for levied funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of West Lafayette, Coshocton County, Ohio that:


Section 1. The Council of the Village of West Lafayette does hereby create and establish a new fund called the POLICE LEVY FUND. The purpose of this fund will be to record and document all receipts and disbursements of levy monies. Interest, if any, derived from any investments from this fund shall be credited to this 218 fund.

Section 2. This Resolution shall take affect be in full force at the earliest time allowed by law.

Section 3. That this resolution shall be and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for reason that the Village needs to establish fund to appropriate 2015 dollars, and for reason thereof this resolution shall be effective immediately upon passage, signing by the Mayor, and posting.
