AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE WATER AND SEWER RATES FOR THE VILLAGE OF WEST LAFAYETTE, OHIO, AMENDING ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTION IN CONFLICT HEREWITH

WHEREAS, a rate increase is required to offset increases in the cost of operations and maintenance of the water and sewer services departments,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of West Lafayette, State of Ohio, as follows:

SECTION 1: That the monthly rates for water consumption by residents of the Village of West Lafayette, Ohio for all billings on the effective date of this ordinance shall be as follows:

<u>SECTION 2</u>: That the monthly sewer rates for residents of the Village of West Lafayette, Ohio, shall be based on water consumption, shall be for all billings on the effective date of this ordinance, and shall be as follows:

\$5.55 per 1000 gallons for water consumption

- SECTION 3: That the minimum billing shall be defined as 2000 gallons per month for water and/ or sewer.
- SECTION 4: Water and sewer connections outside the limits of the Village of West Lafayette, Ohio, shall be billed at one and one-half time the rates as set forth in Section 1 and Section 2 unless otherwise stated in this ordinance.
- SECTION 5: Bulk water purchases may be obtained and water placed into a tank provided by the purchaser. The cost will be \$0.01 per gallon.
- SECTION 6: That the monthly rates for water consumption by the Ridgewood Local Schools Athletic Fields (football and baseball only) on or after January 1, 2013 shall be as follows:

Under 11,000 gallons shall use the same rate structure as in Section 1.

Over 11,000 gallons shall be 50% of the rate in Section 1 until January 1, 2038.
