Minutes of West Lafayette Village Council Regular Meeting on October 24, 2011

West Lafayette Village Council met in regular session at 7:00 P.M., in the municipal building with Mayor Jack L. Patterson presiding.

Pledge of Allegiance

Roll Call: Dave Rogers, Roger Warne, Kelly Gossett, Ron Lusk, Christie Maurer and Dean Wears were present.

A motion was made and seconded to approve the minutes of the October 10, 2011 council meeting. (RC 5 yes, 1 abstained)

Mayor's Correspondence – Mayor Patterson is issuing an executive order to fly all American flags within the village limits at half staff to honor Chief Petty Officer Raymond Border until after his internment. He was killed Wednesday, October 19<sup>th</sup> while in Afghanistan.

Mayor Patterson received a letter from the Ohio Department of Natural Resources informing the village that they were denied funding for the Recreational Trail grant application. ODNR received 67 applications. 24 projects were recommended for funding, totaling \$1.77 million.

Mayor Patterson also received correspondence from Jon Husted, Ohio Secretary of State, encouraging citizens to educate themselves on the three Statewide Ballot Issues:

State Issue 1 – Judicial Retirement Age Constitutional Amendment

State Issue 2 – Referendum on Senate Bill 5

State Issue 3 – Health Care Freedom Amendment

Citizens' comments – Jeff Wherley from Coshocton County Litter Prevention and Recycling updated Mayor and Council with the recycling progress. He is planning on bringing a second collection trailer in the village soon.




