Village Administrator: VA reported that they had a public hearing this evening at 6:30pm for the Zoning Board of Appeals regarding 3 cases. First of all, the board approved an internet based business on West Russell Avenue. Next, the board approved to divide a lot on West Main Street. Finally, the board did not approve the request to put a storage building business on a lot on East Park Avenue. No one showed up for this hearing. Lusk made a motion to accept the recommendation of the Zoning Board of Appeals. Motion seconded by Rogers. (RC 6 yes) The street department is gearing up to start patching Russell Avenue next week. The light control module was approved to be replaced by our insurance company. The new controller has been ordered but will probably be 3 weeks before we receive it. The Village will be reimbursed \$3,460 for this. VA has been asked by a local farmer, Ron Waggoner, if he can make hay off of the field at the Water Treatment Plant. After discussion, council didn't see any reason that this would be a problem. Lusk made a motion to allow Ron Wagner to make hay from this field at the Water Treatment Plant on a trial basis this year. Motion seconded by Rogers. (RC 6 yes)
