RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING AN AGENCY FUND (102) FOR THE ACCOUNTING OF FUNDS RECEIVED FOR A FOOD BANK CONDUCTED BY THE VILLAGE OF WEST LAFAYETTE POLICE DEPARTMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Council for the Village of West Lafayette wishes to accept and utilize donations for a food bank conducted by the Police Department.

WHEREAS, pursuant to standards established by the Auditor of State, it is necessary to create an Agency Fund by resolution of the legislative authority for the purpose of accounting for funds.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of West Lafayette, Coshocton County, Ohio that:

Section 1. The Council of the Village of West Lafayette does hereby create and establish a new fund called the Agency Fund. The purpose of this fund will be to record and document donations utilized for the food bank.

Section 2. Said Police Department-Food Bank- Agency Fund is for the purpose of recording revenue and expenses pertaining to the operation of the food bank.


