## Minutes of West Lafayette Village Council Regular Meeting

West Lafayette Village Council met in special session to discuss Ordinance 2017-12 on March 20, 2017 at 5:00 p.m. in the municipal building with Mayor Stephen R. Bordenkircher presiding.

**Roll Call:** Christie Maurer, Ron Lusk, Tim Cheney, Rich Wheeler, and Craig Bordenkircher were present.

- A motion was made by Craig Bordenkircher and seconded by Christie Maurer to excuse Councilman Bo Fortune. Roll Call 5 yes.

**Citizens:** David Kadri was present to observe.

Mayor Stephen Bordenkircher noted the meeting was called because the previous ordinance that dealt with wages had several changes put into it. In Section 1 A, the pay chart was messed up. Page five of five was incomplete. The mayor believes all of those corrections have been made. The fiscal officer and mayor have gone through it. The mayor believes that it is appropriate. The emergency clause should be used since it affects this week's payroll.

### **2017-12 AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING 2017 PAY SCHEDULE FOR THE VILLAGE OF WEST LAFAYETTE AND REPEALING ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.** First Reading/ Emergency

- A motion was made by Craig Bordenkircher and seconded by Tim Cheney to suspend the rules per the emergency clause added to Ordinance 2017-12. Roll Call 5 yes.
- A motion was made by Craig Bordenkircher and seconded by Rich Wheeler to adopt Ordinance 2017-12. Roll Call 5 yes.

The mayor noted that he spoke with the fiscal officer and the Ordinance Committee. The mayor stated that they need to be very careful with these ordinances. This is the second time that the Payroll Ordinance needed to be addressed in a second meeting. They need to discuss ways when they present an ordinance to the table that it is appropriate and it has been reviewed. It is up to everyone sitting around the table before they vote to look through it. Typically it is sent prior via email. The mayor stated they need to be very cautious.


- A motion was made by Craig Bordenkircher and seconded by Tim Cheney to make Ordinance 2017-12 retroactive to March 13, 2017. Roll Call 5 yes.
- A motion was made by Craig Bordenkircher and seconded by Rich Wheeler to adjourn until the next meeting on Monday, March 27, 2017 at 7:00 p.m. Roll Call 5 yes.
