AN ORDINANCE FOR THE VILLAGE OF WEST LAFAYETTE, COSHOCTON COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO TO ADOPT THE REGIONAL INCOME TAX AGENCY'S (RITA'S) RULES AND REGULATIONS.

WHEREAS, the citizens of the Village of West Lafayette, Coshocton County, Ohio require the efficient and effective collection of taxes.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED OF THE COUNCIL of the village of West Lafayette, Coshocton County, Ohio that:

Section 1: The Village of West Lafayette, Ohio hereby adopts the Regional Income Tax Agency (RITA) Rules & Regulations, including amendments that may be made from time to time, for use as the Village of West Lafayette's Income Tax Rules & Regulations.



Section 3: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effective upon passage, signing by the Mayor, and publication.
