**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY the VILLAGE OF WEST LAFAYETTE COUNCIL:**



**Availability of Local Funds**

I, Fiscal Officer of the Village of West Lafayette, hereby certify that the Village of West Lafayette has the amount of \$46,420.00 in the Sewer Fund and that this amount will be used to pay the local share for the **JOHNSON STREET SANITARY SEWER EXTENSION PROJECT** when it is required.
