**RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE VILLAGE COUNCIL FOR THE VILLAGE OF WEST LAFAYETTE OHIO TO SUBMIT TO THE LECTORATE IN THE NOVEMBER 8, 2018 GENERAL ELECTION AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, Ohio law authorizes a municipality to seek input from voters regarding questions of general interest and seek an advisory opinion;

**WHEREAS**, the Village of West Lafayette has considered purchasing water from the city of Coshocton;

**WHEREAS**, the Council for the Village of West Lafayette is now seeking input from the Citizens of West Lafayette in the General Election, November 8, 2018 for an Advisory Vote in regards to the aforesaid issue;

**WHEREAS**, the Council of the Village of West Lafayette hereby certify the following question to the voters in the Village of West Lafayette, Coshocton County Ohio:

**Shall the Council of the Village of West Lafayette enter into negotiations with the City of Coshocton for the purchase of municipal water?**


The Board of elections for Coshocton County shall Publish the aforementioned question in the 2018 general election on all ballots for the Village of West Lafayette. Costs attributed to the advisory election shall be borne by the Village of West Lafayette.

This resolution is past as an emergency for the peace safety and welfare of the residents of the village of West Lafayette and shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
