RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A JOHNSON STREET SEWER FUND FOR THE ACCOUNTING OF FUNDS FOR THE VILLAGE OF WEST LAFAYETTE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, pursuant to standards established by the Auditor of State, it is necessary to create a Johnson Street Sewer Fund by resolution of the legislative authority for the purpose of accounting for funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of West Lafayette, Coshocton County, Ohio that:


Section 1. The Council of the Village of West Lafayette does hereby create and establish a new 609 fund called the Johnson Street Sewer Fund. The purpose of this fund will be to record and document the use of funds.

Section 2. That this Resolution shall be declared an emergency for necessity of health, safety and welfare of the citizens of West Lafayette, Ohio and shall be effective upon passage and signing by the Mayor.
