SECTION II That the Village Clerk is hereby authorized to draw warrants on the Village Treasury for payments from any foregoing appropriation upon certification and vouchers therefore, approved by the board of officers authorized to approve the same, or an ordinance or resolution of council to make the expenditure; provided that no warrant shall be drawn for salaries or wages expent to payment and have the partle with a first salaries are wages.

salaries or wages except to persons employed by the authority of and in accordance with law or ordinance. Provided further that the appropriations for contingencies can only be expended upon appeal of two-thirds of council for items constituting a legal obligation against the village, and for purposes other than those covered by others specific appropriations herein made.

SECTION III: That the Village of West Lafayette, Ohio declares this ordinance to be an emergency necessary for the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of West Lafayette, Ohio.
