Whereas, the United States Department of Agriculture Federal Assistance Program both provide financial assistance to political subdivisions for non-construction, and

Whereas, the Village of West Lafayette is planning to purchase assets to assist the village, and

Whereas, the assets being purchased herein above described is considered a priority need for the community and is a qualified project under USDA programs,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY the VILLAGE OF WEST LAFAYETTE COUNCIL:

Section 1: The Village Administrator for West Lafayette is hereby authorized to apply to the USDA for fund as described above.

Section 2: The Village Administrator for West Lafayette is further authorized to enter into any agreements as may be necessary and appropriate for obtaining this financial assistance.

Section 3: That this resolution shall be and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the preservation of public peace, health, and safety for the Village of West Lafayette and its inhabitants and shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force and after the earliest period allowed by law.
