### **AN ORDINANCE WAIVING THE RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT FOR THE FISCAL OFFICER, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, the Council for the Village of West Lafayette previously approved, by motion on May 29, 2018, the current Fiscal Officer, Amy Bourne, residing outside of the Village; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 733.262(D) of the Ohio Revised Code, and Section 31.044(B)(4)(a) of the Ohio Basic Code, provides that the Village Fiscal Officer shall become a resident of the Village within six (6) months after her appointment takes effect, unless an ordinance is passed approving the Fiscal Officer's residence outside of the Village; and

**WHEREAS**, the Council for the Village of West Lafayette deems it proper to waive the residency requirement of the current Fiscal Officer, Amy Bourne, by ordinance.


**NOW THEREFORE**, be it ordained by the Council of the Village of West Lafayette, a majority of all Council members concurring that:

**Section 1.** The residency requirement set forth in Section 733.262(D) of the Ohio Revised Code, and Section 31.044(B)(4)(a) of the Ohio Basic Code, is hereby waived for the current Fiscal Officer, Amy Bourne. The Council of the Village of West Lafayette hereby approves the residence of Amy Bourne outside of the Village of West Lafayette while she holds the position of Village Fiscal Officer.


**Section 2.** It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including but not limited to Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**Section 3.** This Ordinance is hereby declared to be a retroactive emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, for the reason that this Ordinance is necessary to comply with the Ohio Revised Code and Ohio Basic Code procedures for waiving the residency requirement of the current Fiscal Officer. For that reason, this Ordinance shall be retroactively effective May 29, 2018, upon proper passage by Council.
