A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE THRASHER GROUP TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE SCHOOL TRAVEL PLAN ON BEHALF OF THE VILLAGE OF WEST LAFAYETTE AND TO EXECUTE CONTRACTS AS REQUIRED AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Whereas, the United States Congress has set aside monies for Safe Routes to School Projects thought the State of Ohio, Department of Transportation; and

Whereas, the Village of West Lafayette can apply for these monies and be selected for funding by the State of Ohio, Department of Transportation; and

Whereas, the School Travel Plan (STP) is an activity eligible to receive federal transportation funding;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY the **VILLAGE OF WEST LAFAYETTE COUNCIL**:

Section 1: The Thrasher Group is hereby empowered on behalf of the Village of West Lafayette to prepare and execute an application for Safe Routes to School (SRTS) STP Development for the stated described project and to submit same to the State of Ohio, Department of Transportation.

Section 2: If awarded the project, no funding will be reimbursed to applicants for School Travel Plan Development. The Village of West Lafayette will be asked to provide information, develop a team, and work with ODOT on plan development. The Village of West Lafayette further agrees to pay One Hundred Percent (100%) of the cost over and above the work provided by the State of Ohio, Department of Transportation.

Section 3: Upon completion of the described Project, the Village of West Lafayette shall provide completed STP with adequate community endorsements.


Section 4: If the application is approved for the STP Development, The Thrasher Group is hereby authorized on behalf of the Village of West Lafayette to enter into a contract with the Director of the Ohio Department of Transportation necessary to complete the above described project.

Section 5: That this resolution shall be and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the reason that it is necessary to meet the Safe Routes to School application deadline and the preservation of public peace, health, and safety for the Village of West Lafayette and its inhabitants and shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force and after the earliest period allowed by law.
