AN ORDINANCE WAIVING THE RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT FOR THE ADMINISTRATOR

WHEREAS, Section 735.271 of the Ohio Revised Code, and Section 31.101(A) of the Ohio Basic Code, provides that the Village Administrator shall become a resident of the Village within six (6) months after his appointment and confirmation takes effect, unless an ordinance is passed approving the Administrator's residence outside of the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Council for the Village of West Lafayette deems it proper to waive the residency requirement of the current Administrator, Chris Menapace.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the Village of West Lafayette, a majority of all Council members concurring that:

- **Section 1.** The residency requirement set forth in Section 735.271 of the Ohio Revised Code, and Section 31.101(A) of the Ohio Basic Code, is hereby waived for the current Administrator, Chris Menapace. The Council of the Village of West Lafayette hereby approves the residence of Chris Menapace outside of the Village of West Lafayette while he holds the position of Village Administrator.
- **Section 2.** It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including but not limited to Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- **Section 3**. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect after the earliest date allowed by law.
