AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 2020-27, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, on May 11, 2020, the Council for the Village of West Lafayette passed Ordinance No. 2020-27, titled "An Ordinance Authorizing The Mayor, Administrator, and Fiscal Officer to Execute a Use Agreement for Waterworks Park with Ridgewood Recreation Board, Repealing Ordinance No. 2015-30, And Declaring an Emergency;" and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section One (1) of Ordinance No. 2020-27, Council approved the Use Agreement attached to Ordinance No. 2020-27 and authorized the Mayor, Administrator, and Fiscal Officer to sign it; and

WHEREAS, in connection with the new Use Agreement and Ordinance No. 2020-27, Council repealed Ordinance No. 2015-30, titled "Ordinance To Amend The Lease Between The Village Of West Lafayette And Ridgewood Recreation;"

WHEREAS, the parties to the Use Agreement have determined to further revise the Use Agreement, and therefore the draft of the Use Agreement attached to Ordinance No. 2020-27 will not be executed by the parties; and

WHEREAS, an updated Use Agreement will be submitted to Village Council at a later date for Council to approve.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED as follows by the Council for the Village of West Lafayette, Ohio:

SECTION I: Council does hereby repeal Ordinance No. 2020-27. Consequently, Ordinance No. 2015-30, titled "Ordinance To Amend The Lease Between The Village Of West Lafayette And Ridgewood Recreation," shall remain in full force and effect until later repealed by Council.

SECTION II: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare. The reason for such necessity is that the Use Agreement attached to Ordinance No. 2020-27 will not be executed by the parties and therefore this Ordinance is immediately necessary to accurately reflect the current agreement between the parties, which was further addressed in Ordinance No. 2015-30 and in a prior written agreement between the Village and the Ridgewood Recreation Board. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into immediate effect upon passage.
