AN ORDINANCE WAIVING THE RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT FOR THE POLICE CHIEF

WHEREAS, Section 737.15 of the Ohio Revised Code, and Section 34.02(A) of the Ohio Basic Code, provides that the Village Police Chief shall become a resident of the Village within six (6) months after his appointment and confirmation takes effect, unless an ordinance is passed approving the Police Chief's residence outside of the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Council for the Village of West Lafayette deems it proper to waive the residency requirement of the current Police Chief, Matthew Fohl.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the Village of West Lafayette, a majority of all Council members concurring that:

- **Section 1.** The residency requirement set forth in Section 737.15 of the Ohio Revised Code, and Section 34.02(A) of the Ohio Basic Code, is hereby waived for the current Police Chief, Matthew Fohl. The Council of the Village of West Lafayette hereby approves the residence of Matthew Fohl outside of the Village of West Lafayette while he holds the position of Police Chief.
- **Section 2.** It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including but not limited to Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- **Section 3**. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect after the earliest date allowed by law.
