AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, ADMINISTRATOR, AND FISCAL OFFICER TO EXECUTE A USE AGREEMENT FOR WATERWORKS PARK WITH RIDGEWOOD RECREATION BOARD, REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 2015-30, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, on or about March 15, 2016, the Village of West Lafayette and Ridgewood Recreation Board ("RRB") entered into an "Amended Lease Agreement" regarding RRB's use of a certain portion of Waterworks Park (the "Property") for the purpose of RRB organizing and operating youth baseball/softball/tee ball games and practices (the "Events") at the Property; and

WHEREAS, the Village of West Lafayette and RRB have determined that the 2016 Agreement should be terminated and a new "Use Agreement" should be entered into between the parties to accurately reflect the current terms of the parties' agreement concerning the Property; and

WHEREAS, RRB's use of the Property for the Events provides a benefit to the community, and therefore the Village wishes to enter into the new Use Agreement with RRB; and

WHEREAS, the new agreement will render Ordinance No. 2015-30, titled "Ordinance To Amend The Lease Between The Village Of West Lafayette And Ridgewood Recreation" obsolete and unnecessary, and therefore the Ordinance should be repealed for clarity purposes.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED as follows by the Council for the Village of West Lafayette, Ohio:

SECTION I: Council does hereby approve the Use Agreement between the Village and RRB, attached hereto, and authorizes the Mayor, Administrator, and Fiscal Officer to execute the Use Agreement Between the Village of West Lafayette and the Ridgewood Recreation Board.


SECTION II: Council hereby repeals Ordinance No. 2015-30, titled "Ordinance to Amend The Lease Between The Village Of West Lafayette And Ridgewood Recreation."

SECTION III: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare. The reason for such necessity is that the Use Agreement has an effective date of July 27, 2020, and the Ordinance is necessary to provide full authority for the Fiscal Officer and Administrator and/or Mayor to sign the required agreement. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into immediate effect upon passage.
