
AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE FISCAL OFFICER AND VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO SIGN AND EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY WITH KOBEL'S LANDSCAPING FOR THE RECLAMATION OF THE PROPERTIES DAMAGED DURING THE JOHNSON STREET SEWER EXTENSION PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Village of West Lafayette desires to enter into an agreement with Kobel's Landscaping for the reclamation of the properties that were damaged during the Johnson Street Sewer Project; and

WHEREAS, the Village of West Lafayette and Kobel's Landscaping have determined that there are 22 properties located on 5th Street, Wall Street, Johnson Street and Platt Street that are in need of the reclamation; and

WHEREAS, Kobel's Landscaping has provided an estimate in the amount of \$19,660.00 (Nineteen thousand six hundred and sixty dollars) for the reclamation of the 22 aforementioned properties; and

WHEREAS, the property owners receiving the reclamation will be entitled to receive a 50% (fifty percent) credit on their water bill for two – three (2-3) consecutive billing cycles, to be determined by the Village Administrator, in order to provide adequate watering which will assist with the grass growing process.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of West Lafayette;


Section 1: That the Fiscal Officer and Village Administrator are hereby authorized to approve any and all documentation necessary for the work performed by Kobel's Landscaping to occur.

Section 2: That this ordinance shall be and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the reason that the Village must complete all necessary documentation to begin the reclamation process to preserve the health and safety of the citizens of the Village therefore this ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage, signing by the Mayor, and posting.
