Attention Residents,

The Coshocton Water Project is well underway and the construction within our community is now beginning. We will do our absolute best to keep you informed of what to expect relative to overall project progression and what to expect in your neighborhood. Please understand, that with projects of this scale, sometimes changes in plans occur at the ground level and the construction crew could deviate from the plan we have posted in order to remain productive. Again, we will remain diligent in keeping you informed of such changes as they might occur.

The overall project will proceed in the following manner:

- New water lines will be installed beginning at the intersection of Gay and Main Street this week.
- Crews will begin sawing roads today, and if time permits, they will begin to saw driveways impacted by the project. You will know if your driveway, or property is impacted by the project if you have pink paint on your driveway or stakes with blue ribbon on the top in your yard.
- Not all of the sawing will be completed this week. The concentration will be the roads and the southern portion of the Village
- The flow of the project will, again start at Gay and Main, proceed south to 7th Street and then go east and west on 7th.
- After 7th is completed, installing the main line only, NOT SERVICE CONNECTIONS TO YOUR HOME, the crews will move north to 6th, then 5th, then 4th, then the small section of Union.
- This work will take well over 3 months to complete.

We will pass on information as soon as we receive it in order to help answer any of your question as the project proceeds. More information will come more frequently over the winter and into spring when individual service lines to your homes will begin to be installed.
