A RESOLUTION EXTENDING THE RESIDENCY SEARCH FOR THE POLICE CHIEF

WHEREAS, Section 737.15 of the Ohio Revised Code, and Section 34.02(A) of the Ohio Basic Code, provides that the Village Police Chief shall become a resident of the Village within six (6) months after his appointment and confirmation takes effect, unless an ordinance is passed approving the Police Chief's residence outside of the Village; and

WHEREAS, on June 8, 2020, the Council for the Village of West Lafayette approved by motion to waive the residency requirement within the Village for the new Police Chief and to allow a 30-minute travel time from the residence of the Police Chief to the Village; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2020-38 was passed by Council on July 27, 2020 approving the Police Chief's residence outside of the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Police Chief has not been able to find a residence within a 30-minute travel time to the Village.


NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the Village of West Lafayette, a majority of all Council members concurring that:

Section 1. The Council of the Village of West Lafayette hereby approves a one-hundred eighty (180) day extension of time to locate a residence within a 30-minute travel time to the Village for Chief Matthew Fohl.


Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including but not limited to Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, for the reason that the Police Chief's probationary period has expired and shall take effect and be in full force and effect immediately from and after its passage.
