
A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE FISCAL OFFICER AND FIRE CHIEF TO SIGN AND EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY WITH ADVANTECH SERVICES AND PARTS FOR PURCHASE OF TURNOUT GEAR AND NOMEX HOODS

WHEREAS, the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act, 116 Public law 136 (the "CARES Act") was signed into law by the President of the United States on March 27, 2020;

WHEREAS, the Ohio General Assembly established a process for distributing funds provided by the CARES Act in House Bill 481 of the 133rd General Assembly;

WHEREAS, the Village of West Lafayette has received \$177,288.13 in distributions from the State of Ohio;

WHEREAS, the Village of West Lafayette Volunteer Fire Department desire to contract with Advantech Services and Parts for the purchase turn out gear and Nomex hoods for the firefighters;

WHEREAS, the Village of West Lafayette has obtained a quote in the amount of \$45,140.00 (Forty-five thousand, one hundred forty dollars and no cents) from Advantech Services and Parts;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of West Lafayette;

Section 1: That the Fiscal Officer and Fire Chief are hereby authorized to sign and execute all documents necessary for this purchase.


