A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE AND DIRECT THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS FOR SALE OF A DE-COMMISSIONED POLICE CRUISER AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Council for the Village of West Lafayette, Ohio is desirous of selling a used 2010 Ford Crown Victoria Police Interceptor; and

WHERAS, Council for the Village of West Lafayette, Ohio declares that it is the owner of the used 2010 Ford Crown Victoria Police Interceptor, and that it is no longer needed for public use, and

WHEREAS, Council has reviewed the request by the Village Administrator in open meeting and intends to make a decision.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council for the Village of West Lafayette Ohio, authorizes and directs the Village Administrator to advertise for the invitation of bids for sale of the 2010 Ford Crown Victoria Police Interceptor as specified below:

<u>Section 1</u>: Specification for the invitation to bid and the newspaper publication is attached as "Exhibit A" and is incorporated herein as though fully rewritten. The estimated value of the vehicle is approximately Two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250.00). Therefore, a minimum bid of Two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250.00) will be required in order for the vehicle to be purchased. As per Ohio revised code Section 721.15 (a) the advertisement shall be published for not less than two (2) consecutive weeks in a local newspaper of general publication. The Village shall reserve the right to reject any and all bids and the bid for sale if awarded, shall be awarded to the highest and best bidder.

Section 2: That this Resolution shall be declared an emergency for necessity of health, safety and welfare of the citizens of West Lafayette, Ohio for the reasons that the sale of this items can best be facilitated as soon as possible as the Village wishes to remove the vehicle from its fleet and off of its property and shall be effective upon passage and signing by the Mayor.

The vehicle does not have a functioning transmission and needs the head gasket replaced. The vehicle has approximately 120,000 miles. The vehicle is being sold as is, where is, and without warranty. The successful bidder shall be responsible for delivery.

The estimated value of the vehicle is approximately Two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250.00). Therefore, a minimum bid of Two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250.00) will be required in order for the vehicle to be purchased.
