AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, THE VILLAGE
ADMINISTRATOR, AND FISCAL OFFICER TO EXECUTE ALL NECESSARY
DOCUMENTS FOR THE VILLAGE OF WEST LAFAYETTE TO ENTER INTO A
WASTEWATER AGREEMENT WITH PEARL VALLEY CHEESE, REPEALING
ORDINANCE 2021-39, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, on or about April 23, 2018, the Village of West Lafayette and the Coshocton County Board of Commissioner ("County") entered into an agreement, with an effective date of April 23, 2018, whereby the Village agreed to maintain and operate the sanitary sewer system owned by the County and known as the Fresno/Pearl Sanitary Sewer System ("County Sewer System"); and

WHEREAS, the County wishes to transfer ownership of the County Sewer System, all of its real property, all off the easements associated with the County Sewer System, all of the assets associated with the County Sewer System; and

WHEREAS, the Village needs to enter into an agreement with Pearl Valley Cheese separate to the agreement with the County. Pearl Valley Cheese is an industrial producer of wastewater and therefore will have its own rate structure, maintenance agreement, and regulations placed upon them as indicated in Exhibit A of this ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED as follows by the Council for the Village of West Lafayette, Ohio:

SECTION I: Council does hereby approve the Wastewater Agreement with Pearl Valley Cheese ("Exhibit A"), attached hereto.

SECTION II: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare. The reason for such necessity is that the transfer of ownership of the County Sewer System will have an effective date of the first day of the month following the signature of all exhibits attached hereto by the properly identified representatives of Pearl Valley Cheese, the Village Fiscal Officer, Administrator, and Mayor. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into immediate effect upon passage.
