

A RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE 2021 PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS ORDINANCE 2020-87, ADDING FUNDS

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of West Lafayette, State of Ohio as follows:

SECTION I: That there be and hereby an addition to the following funds as follows:

101.101.523500 **\$3,000.00**

In the 101 General Fund, funds are needed to cover the tear-down and scans for the Police Department Chevy Tahoe at Brillhart's, towing and removal of equipment. All expenses will be reimbursed by the insurance company.

602.109.523000 **\$2,000.00**

602.801.526302 **\$9,549.89**


In the 602 Sewer Fund, funds are needed for light repairs at the WWTP and to pay off the OWDA loan 9043 for the preliminary storm water trunk-line conveyance plan. Funds were reimbursed from the 212 American Rescue Plan Fund to cover the loan payoff.

SECTION II: That this Resolution shall be declared an emergency measure necessary to preserve the health, welfare and safety of the citizens of the Village of West Lafayette, Ohio, the emergency being so the Village can pay bills in a timely manner and shall take effect immediately upon passage by Council and signing of the Mayor.
