

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 76.04 OF THE OHIO BASIC CODE TITLED "PARKING PROHIBITIONS", AND SECTION 76.05 OF THE OHIO BASIC CODE TITLED "PARKING NEAR CURB; PRIVILEGES FOR PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES" AND ESTABLISHING PENALTIES.

WHEREAS, the present general and permanent ordinances of the municipality are inadequately arranged and classified and are insufficient in form and substance for the complete preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the municipality and for the proper conduct of its affairs; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to provide for the usual daily operation of the municipality and for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the municipality that this ordinance take effect at an early date.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL of the Village of West Lafayette, Coshocton County, Ohio that:

Section 1. Section 76.04 of the Ohio Basic Code titled "Parking Prohibitions" is hereby amended to read as follows.

76.04 Parking Prohibitions

(A) No person shall stand or park a vehicle, except when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic or to comply with the provisions of this title, or while obeying the directions of a police officer or a traffic-control device, in any of the following places or conditions:

- (1) Parking on Sidewalk
- (2) Blocking Public or Private Drive
- (3) Within an Intersection
- (4) Within 10 feet a of Fire Hydrant
- (5) On a Crosswalk
- (6) Within Twenty Feet of a Crosswalk
- (7) Within 30 Feet of a Traffic Control
- (8) Between a Marked Safety Zone
- (9) Within 50 Feet of a Railroad Crossing
- (10) Within 20 Feet of Driveway Entrance to a Fire Station
- (11) Alongside/Opposite Any Street Excavation
- (12) Alongside a Vehicle Parked at the Curb
- (13) Along Yellow Curb, or Any Place Where Signs Prohibit Parking
- (14) Within One Foot of Another Vehicle
- (15) On the Roadway

Section 2. Section 76.05 of the Ohio Basic Code titled "Parking Near Curb; Privileges for Persons with Disabilities.

76.05 Parking Near Curb; Privileges for Persons with Disabilities.

- (1) Every vehicle stopped or parked upon a roadway where there is an adjacent curb shall be stopped or parked with the right-hand wheels of the vehicle parallel with and not more than 12 inches from the right-hand curb.
- (2) No vehicle shall be stopped or parked on a road or highway with the vehicle facing in a direction other than the direction of travel on that side of the road or highway.

Section 3. Penalty.

All violators of parking regulations under this ordinance shall be fined fifty dollars (\$50.00) per offense, unless otherwise specified.

Section 4. Whenever reference is made in any documents, publications, or signs of the Village, including but not limited to traffic tickets and traffic-control signs, to a section as it existed in a former edition of the Ohio Basic Code, the reference shall extend and apply to the section referred to as subsequently amended, revised, re-codified, or renumbered.

Section 5. This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health safety and general welfare of the people of the Village and shall take effect at the earliest date provided by law.
