In the 201 Street Fund, funds are needed in the Maintenance and Supplies account to cover expenses for the remainder of 2022 due to the rising costs of supplies.

In the 602 Sewer Fund, funds are needed for the increased cost of Village liability insurance with the addition of the Pearl Valley and Fresno assets.

SECTION II: That this Resolution shall be declared an emergency measure necessary to preserve the health, welfare and safety of the citizens of the Village of West Lafayette, Ohio, the emergency being to assure timely payments to vendors and shall take effect immediately upon passage by Council and signing of the Mayor.
