Military Banner Program

The Village of West Lafayette (along with other county villages and the City of Coshocton) has partnered with Blue Star Mothers for a Military Banner Program. Active military members, veterans, or family of veterans may make an application for a 24" x 37" banner to be placed in the Village, beginning on Main Street through North Kirk Street to honor military members or veterans in our area. Banners will be displayed in the City or Village of preference. The total cost of this banner will be \$45.00, and the Village will take care of hanging and storing the banners. All applications, money and pictures should be sent to the Blue Star Mothers, noted on the application. Applications are available on the Village website or in the Village Administration office. Banners will be hung as they are received.
